for the Savannah River Liquid Waste Program

Pre-Solicitation Facilities Tour

I. TOUR LOGISTICS

A tour of the Savannah River Site (SRS) Liquid Waste facilities will be held on **Tuesday, April 17**. Directions to SRS can be found at <http://www.srs.gov/general/about/where1.htm>

The tour involves significant walking. It is therefore recommended that all participants wear comfortable walking shoes; and, that female participants refrain from wearing dresses or skirts. If special accommodations are required, please notify Mr. Stephenson when registering for the tour. The tour is expected to be completed by 4:30 p.m.

Questions will not be entertained during the tour.

II. TOUR REGISTRATION

Individuals who wish to participate in the tour must pre-register. Pre-registration, however, does not guarantee the pre-registered individual a spot on the tour. DOE may limit the number of participants on the tour due to national security concerns and/or tour logistics.

U.S. citizens wishing to pre-register for the tour must provide the following information:

With the exception of foreign nationals from sensitive countries (see Attachment 1), foreign nationals may pre-register for the tour. Foreign nationals wishing to pre-register for the tour must provide the information requested in Attachment 2 as soon as possible so that DOE has adequate time to comply with all necessary security policies and procedures.

All badging requests must be provided to Scott Stephenson at Scott.Stephenson@srs.gov no later than 4:00 p.m. on **April 6, 2007**. **Subsequent thereto, Mr. Stephenson will notify the individuals who will participate in the tour.** Tour participants must report to the SRS Badge Office located in Building 703-46A off of SRS Road 1 at 7:00 a.m. for visitor badge processing. You must be on time and bring **two forms of ID, one of which must be a photo ID**. Acceptable forms of identification for both U.S. Citizens and

foreign nationals is provided in Attachment 3.

A no-host lunch will be available to tour participants.

III. POTENTIAL HAZARDS

It is DOE's intent to provide facility tours which will include entrance into an industrial working environment that poses routine industrial and radiological hazards. Due to the requirement to perform radiological monitoring in exiting certain facilities, it is recommended that cotton clothing be worn to avoid naturally occurring radon/thoron contamination of clothing.

IV. SECURITY ISSUES

Security requirements dictate that all participants remain with the tour group for the duration of the tour. There are also several prohibited items that are not allowed at SRS. These items are real or simulated firearms and ammunition, stun guns, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and paraphernalia, explosives, hand-held weapons, chemical irritants, and items prohibited by state and federal law. Other items not allowed on the tour are copying devices, electronic recording devices, cameras, radios, cellular telephones, blackberries (an emergency number will be available), and knives with blades more than 3 inches long. **Contraband brought to SRS will be confiscated.**

Please be aware that **all** hand carried items (packages, briefcases, handbags, purses, etc.) will be inspected prior to boarding the bus.
